History of Franklin Avenue Shelter

- Former Rainbow Motel
 - Built in 1930 (22 units)
 - Back built in 1980s (28 units)
- Purchased by the City in January 2022
 - Redevelopment
 - Briefly housed Turnkey Shelter during the renovation
 - Franklin Avenue Shelter opened May 2023



Funding for Franklin Operations



Agreement with Central Oregon Intergovernmental Council

- Governor's Executive Order 23-02 Funds
 - Award: \$932,582.00
 - Expiration Date: January 10, 2024
- Amendment
 - Approved by Council 1/3
 - Additional \$127,868.00
 - Extends Expiration Date: June 30, 2024
- **Total EO Award \$1,060,450**

Other Funding Allocations:

- City of Bend \$750,000 of ARPA
- Deschutes County \$750,000 of ARPA



Franklin Avenue Shelter

- Operator: Shepherd's House Ministries
- 60 Beds Low-Barrier Shelter in Franklin Shelter
- Opened May 2023
- Services include case management, daily meals, connections to partner providers
- December 2023:
 - 61 Clients Served
 - 14 families
 - 22 individuals who are medically vulnerable
