MPO Boundary Update</b>	<p><b>Background</b>  After each decennial census, the Census Bureau adjusts the Urbanized Area Boundary (UZA) and Federal Aid Urban Boundary (FAUB) for every city to reflect population growth and land use changes. State DOTs then work with cities to adjust the FAUB to incorporate local conditions. The MPO boundary must include all areas identified within the FAUB.
