- The Ways and Means statewide roadshow is underway. The co-chairs of the budget committee have released their **budget priorities framework** outlining available resources for the state budget. LOC members are encouraged to attend and advocate for priorities that would benefit their city.

## Oregon Transportation Re-Investment Package (TRIP) 2025

A framework for the **Oregon Transportation Re-Investment Package (TRIP)** has been created. Nearly 90% of the investment will be dedicated to operations, maintenance and preservation efforts and the remaining funds will honor previous project commitments from the last transportation package.
