Moody's Rating: Bend 2025 FF&C Bonds

Moody's Ratings (Moody's) has assigned a Aa2 to Bend's upcoming sale of \$99.7 million in Full Faith and Credit Bonds, Series 2025. They maintain the Aa2 on the City's issuer rating, general obligation unlimited tax (GOULT) and full faith and credit (FF&C) bonds. Post-sale, Bend will have around \$357 million in debt outstanding. The outlook is stable which reflects the likelihood that Bend's financial position will remain healthy, supported by diverse revenue streams and proactive financial management.
