


Affordable Housing Accomplishments

July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025

The City of Bend measures progress towards achieving goals that address the affordable housing, public services, and community development needs of low- and moderate-income households in Bend each fiscal year. At the recommendation of the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC), the City of Bend awards funding competitively to applicants that share its established funding priorities. Spending during the 2024-2025 fiscal year supported community partners in the development of affordable housing and the provision of public services. In each community investment, the City is joined by multiple funding partners, allowing projects and providers to leverage their impact.





