Funds to Bend from Housing and Urban Development

- Currently, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) offers the City of Bend funding under two programs
 - Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and
 - Pathways to Reducing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing)
- As a Recipient of these funds, Bend distributes these resources to subrecipient programs serving the community



Executive Orders Appearing in Proposed Agreements



EO 14168 – Recipients shall ensure that no portion of the grant is applied to the promotion of gender ideology



EO 14182 – Recipients shall ensure that no portion of the grant is applied to the funding or advocacy of elective abortions



EO 14218 – Recipients must ensure compliance with immigration restrictions and requirements when managing grant funds, including eligibility and verification processes

PRWORA Notice

- On November 26, 2025, the Office of the General Council at HUD defined the term “Federal public benefit” as it pertains to the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA)
